- Good discussion of topics. More concrete lectures with clear objectives.
- The neutrals are not an indictment of Jim. I was unable to attend recitations because I had a class
  during it; I wish the recitation time had been announced beforehand somehow, even if in the end it
  wasn't entirely necessary for the class, b/c I would have liked to attend them. Otherwise, when I was
  able to interact with Jim, he was pretty helpful.
- While I did not attend the optional recitation sections, James was extremely helpful at providing feedback on submitted assignments or questions about the class material incredible promptly. No suggestions.
- Socratic method classes made it seem like a real law school class. Not sure what I would improve.
- Very responsive, but wish there was more thorough feedback on assignments.
- James was great. The only critique I have is that the class description didn't mention a recitation at
  all and they threw one in (which was objectively amazing and it was nice to have that extra support),
  but they were only ever held on Tuesdays when I'm working, so I never was able to make it to any of
  them. It would have been nice if there was a more democratic way of scheduling the recitations, or if
